Co-Defendants Status Calendar Request

Effective immediately, the Superior Court Judges and Clerk direct that counsel give prior notice to the Clerk for each case on the Criminal Status Calendar that involves co-defendants so that co-defendant's cases can be heard together.

Notice must be given by 4:30 p.m. on the day before the Status Calendar, and can be given by simply replying to the Clerk's e-mail which sends the calendar, clearly informing the Clerk which cases are to be called together.

Due to the time required to prepare notes for each defendant's case, prior notice is essential if the calendar is to proceed efficiently.

In matters involving co-defendants where timely notice is not given to the Clerk, these cases shall be heard at the end of the calendar.
