EXECUTIVE ORDER 97-08

Adjustment to Health Department Fees

WHEREAS, due to fluctuations in price for vaccine utilized by the Health Department, it is necessary to allow for adjustments in price of immunizations delivered to the public, and

WHEREAS, prices for vital records supplied by the State of Washington have increased since the Unified Fee Schedule was adopted, and

WHEREAS, the administration is desirous of establishing the means of making adjustments to the prices charged by the Health Department for these services,

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the power vested in me by the Home Rule Charter for Whatcom County, I hereby authorize, effective immediately, the Whatcom County Health Department be enabled to adjust the price charged for immunizations to citizens requesting such inoculations to accurately reflect the actual costs incurred for the vaccine. A price listing should be available with the revised amounts.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the prices for vital records charged by the Whatcom County Health Department be adjusted according to the increases in fees charged by the State of Washington for such records. A revised listing of these charges will be posted.
