Subject: Comment on Gateway Pacific Terminal permit and SEPA process

I am requesting that your agencies hold SSA to the highest possible standards of public accountability based on its unpermitted destruction of sensitive wetlands. This action has increased community anxiety about SSA's proposal for the Gateway Pacific Terminal and to allay fears, SSA should be required to go above and beyond normal permit processing and SEPA review requirements.

Therefore, I hope that you will require SSA to update its JARPA application as part of the new shoreline application process. The current JARPA is based on an outdated shoreline permit. The SEPA process is technically difficult for the general public to follow. Providing outdated project information from an invalid shoreline permit will only add to public frustration, confusion and distrust of SSA and the agencies that have regulatory authority. The SEPA scoping process should not move forward prior to submittal of a new JARPA.

I suggest that your agencies hold a public meeting to provide information on the application and SEPA process and explain the complicated background of this case. This will not only inform the public, but should result in public comments that will be more helpful to your agencies. This should be done prior to scoping to help inform the SEPA process.

I also believe that the EIS process should be handled with sensitivity to avoid claims that SSA tainted the process. At a minimum, only the regulatory agencies should be involved in the consultant selection process. Better yet, allow REsources to select the consultant that will be used. Given SSA's power and influence, this is a decision that should be given great consideration. Ideally, the consultant will have not had prior dealings, particularly of a financial nature, with SSA and its subsidiaries, and will not be likely to

solicit future work from SSA.

Hello Tyler:

This is an update on the unpermitted clearing, grading, and road construction activities on the GPT project. On February 13, 2012, I met with Rich Sluss, DNR Glacier District Manager, and Shannon Clark, DNR Forester, to discuss the unpermitted clearing, grading, and road construction work implemented by the applicant back in July 2011. Several attendees at the December 13, 2011 GPT MAP team meeting raised the concern over the validity of DNR interpreting the unpermitted activities as not being conversion. During that MAP team meeting, I was tasked with consulting with you (Whatcom County) and DNR to become more fully informed on the rationale for a determination of non-conversion. I greatly appreciate Rich's time and energy spent explaining DNR's interpretation. Having had experience with these matters, I did not understand Rich's explanation. I reviewed the definition of "conversion activities" with Rich and continue to come to a different interpretation than his. Rich suggested that I contact Sue Casey at DNR's Olympia office to seek further explanation. Below is the email message I sent to Sue Casey on February 17, 2012 asking for clarification on DNR's interpretation and decision regarding the unpermitted activities. Although I have not heard back from Sue Casey, in the mean time, I wanted to let you know that some progress has been made on this issue based on the tasking from the December 13, 2011 GPT MAP team meeting.

Also, it is interesting to note that DNR's interpretation of non-conversion was presenting in an Informal Conference Note (ICN #130128). DNR considers information in an ICN to be non-binding. As such, the issue over conversion vs. non-conversion is essentially unresolved.

Thanks for all of your hard work and diligence in these matters. Let me know if you have any comments or questions.

Dear Ms. Casey:

I appreciate the time that Rich Sluss and Shannon Clark spent in meeting with us in regard to the Gateway Pacific Terminal project earlier this week. Rich did a good job of explaining how he interpreted the unpermitted clearing work at the GPT site to not be conversion. Rich suggested that if I have additional questions to direct them to you.

The question I have is: doesn't the unpermitted falling of trees, clearing native vegetation, pulling stumps, and constructing roads in forest lands for the purposes of geotechnical investigations connected to a declared intent to develop the site for industrial use qualify as conversion under WAC 222-16-010? The definition states:

" "Conversion activities" means activities associated with conversions of forest land to land uses other than commercial timber operation. These activities may be occurring during or after timber harvest on forest land. They may include but are not limited to the following:

* Any of, or any combination of, the following activities in preparation for nonforestry use of the land: Grading, filling, or stump removal."

* Preparation for, or construction of, any structure requiring local government approval."

Future industrial development at this site is not speculative; rather, it is an activity that has been contemplated for many years and County zoning has planned for such development. Clearly there is a direct connection between the unpermitted forest practices and the declared intent to develop the site. Under most common natural resources regulations, all incremental activities considered to be connected to an overall project must be considered in the overall review and/or permitting of a project, not segmented or piecemealed. In other words, the connection between the geotechnical testing and stated intent to develop the site should mandate that the unpermitted activities be interpreted as conversion.

Finally, why would DNR interpret these unpermitted activities as non-conversion based on reforestation of a site that will be developed well before the planted trees become trees? Reforesting the graded areas as a condition of the Notice to Comply does not appear to kick the unpermitted activities out of the conversion category since the activities were not approved prior to being implemented, but after the operator had applied for major County development permits.

I am asking these questions because they relate to an action item that was assigned to me during the December 13, 2011 GPT MAP team meeting that involves meeting with Whatcom County and DNR to learn more about the rationale for DNR's determination that the unpermitted activities did not constitute conversion.

I would appreciate your timely response to my request.

Attached is a new policy which applies to those who either **work on grants OR work on projects that have "restricted funding."**

We have received directive from Finance for all PDS staff to account for hours worked directly on your weekly timesheets, as opposed to the retro-active approach of charging it to your home cost center, then transferring it to a different cost center after the fact.

Many of you do not work on grants, but keep in mind that projects such as the GPT EIS will have a separate cost center in the coming months, so if you work on the EIS, you will need to charge the hours worked that day to the cost center associated with GPT.

Statement: The purpose of this policy is to create a uniform system for all staff who work on grants defining how to account for their hours on their weekly timesheet. This also applies to projects with restricted funding – ie: other projects which are not your 'home' cost center.

All employees who work on grants (or other projects with restricted funding) must enter their grant hours on their time sheet each week. Wherever possible, hours will be in quarter-hour increments. These hours must be actual hours worked on that day, not an estimate nor an average for the week.

This policy will avoid many possible errors and vagueness in assigning payroll costs to the grants retroactively. It also adheres to applicable laws from OMB Circular A-87.

For the correct method to enter your weekly time for payroll, here is an example:

You work an 8 hour/day schedule, 40 hours a week, and the cost centers are 2500 for PDS work, 2580 for Grant ABC, and 2586 for Grant XYZ. For the week, the hours you worked on grants are as follows:

- Monday: 5 hours PDS work, 3 hours on Grant XYZ
- Tuesday: 4.5 hours PDS work, 3.5 hours on Grant ABC
- Wednesday: 8 hours Grant ABC
- Thursday: 7 hours PDS work, 1 hour Grant XYZ
- Friday: 8 hours vacation

Your time card would be filled out like the example below. As with all timesheets, you and your supervisor will sign and date.

Yes, there will be a Determination of Significance and Scoping notice that will be issued that will lay out the project description, references to additional information on the project, scoping meetings (time/date) and additional information to help scope the comments. The comments to the DS/Scoping Notice should be as specific as possible.

2) Once the scoping period begins, what is the length of the public comment period?

The length of the public comment period has not been determined to date. It has been discussed and likely that expanding scoping will be used which typically allows scoping to run for 30 days. The period of scoping (30 days - 60 day) will be formalized through the DS/Scoping Notice.
