
Dear Mr. Sahlin;

On October 12, 2011, Whatcom County issued the above referenced Land Disturbance Permit, which authorized previous and planned land disturbance related to geotechnical work on Pacific International Terminals, Inc. property. The land disturbance permit also authorized required reforestation work. On May 24, 2012, you granted an extension until November 26, 2012.

With this letter I am requesting an extension to Land Disturbance Permit number LDP2011-00054.

As you are aware, the remaining geotechnical investigation and reforestation have not been completed because authorizations required from the Department of Ecology and US Army Corps of Engineers have not been issued. We fully intend to implement the plans once the authorizations are issued.
