

COUNCIL ACTION TAKEN

The Whatcom County Council adopted the following at its August 10, 2010, meeting:

1. ORDINANCE (2010-034) IMPOSING AN INTERIM MORATORIUM ON THE ACCEPTANCE OF NEW APPLICATIONS FOR DIVISIONS OF LAND RESULTING IN LOTS SMALLER THAN FIVE ACRES WITHIN THE LAKE WHATCOM WATERSHED (AB2010-101A):

This ordinance imposes a moratorium on the acceptance of new applications for divisions of land into lots of smaller than five acres in the Lake Whatcom watershed. All lots that remain five acres or greater shall be exempt from this subdivision moratorium. This ordinance shall be effective for not longer than six months following its effective date, but may be renewed for one or more six-month periods if subsequent public hearings are held and findings of fact are made prior to each renewal.

2. ORDINANCE (2010-035) AMENDING CHAPTER 20.90 OF THE OFFICIAL WHATCOM COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE RELATING TO INITIATING ZONING AMENDMENTS (AB2010-270A):

This ordinance amends Whatcom County Code (WCC) 20.90 to allow the county council to initiate zoning amendments for further review at any time during the year, subject to county council review of ongoing staff resources and legislative priorities.

3. ORDINANCE (2010-036) AMENDING THE 2010 BUDGET, REQUEST NO. 14 (AB2010-290):

This ordinance adds appropriations to the Planning and Development Services, Conservation Futures Fund, in the amount of \$771,900.

4. ORDINANCE (2010-037) AMENDING ORDINANCE 2009-071, THE OFFICIAL WHATCOM COUNTY ZONING MAP, AND THE WHATCOM COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AND MAPS, TO IMPLEMENT CHANGES RELATING TO COMPLETION OF THE 10 YEAR REVIEW OF THE URBAN GROWTH AREAS REQUIRED UNDER THE GROWTH MANAGEMENT ACT (AB2010-054D):

This ordinance amends Ordinance 2009-071, Whatcom County Zoning Map and the Comprehensive Plan and maps to implement changes relating to the 10 year review of the urban growth areas (UGA's) required under the Growth Management Act, specifically the UGA's of Birch Bay and Ferndale.
