Amendment: ARTICLE 3 THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH Section 3.21 Election and Term of Office. The County Executive shall be nominated and elected by the voters of the county, and the term of office shall be four years and until the successor is elected and qualified. The County Executive shall serve no more than three full consecutive terms in office. Terms are considered consecutive unless they are at least four years apart.
