Planned Service Outages for the Lummi Island Ferry

Whatcom County Public Works would like to inform the public of necessary Lummi Island Ferry outages related to dock improvements on the Lummi Island ferry terminal.

On May 21, 2016 and May 22, 2016, Whatcom County maintenance crews will need a block of uninterrupted time to work through the night to complete the Lummi Island dock improvement project.

Accordingly on Saturday, May 21, 2016 the Lummi Island ferry will stop running after the 10:10 p.m. run. The last evening run from the Gooseberry Point side will be 10:10 p.m. and the last evening run from the Lummi Island side will be 10:00 p.m. The Whatcom Chief will return to its normal schedule on Sunday, May 22, 2016 at 7:00 a.m.

Additionally on Sunday, May 22, 2016 the Lummi Island ferry will again stop running after the 10:10 p.m. run. The last evening run from the Gooseberry Point side will be 10:10 p.m. and the last evening run from the Lummi Island side will be 10:00 p.m. The Whatcom Chief will return its normal schedule on Monday, May 23, 2016 at 5:40 a.m.

These improvements are weather dependent and may be rescheduled for a later time if necessary.

The Public Works Department would like to thank everyone in advance for their cooperation and patience during these necessary dock improvement related ferry closures.
