Site Monitoring this Winter

Due to the deteriorated state of the existing culvert, this site will be monitored closely this fall & winter to ensure the safety of the traveling public.

Should conditions at the site change requiring a closure of Slater Road a signed detour will be utilized.

Project Details

- ◆ The Whatcom County Public Works Department is planning to replace an existing 10-foot wide by 7-foot tall steel arch culvert under Slater Road at Jordan Creek during the 2017 construction season.
- ◆ The existing culvert has deteriorated and is considered a barrier to fish passage and will be replaced with an approximately 140-foot span bridge.

Traffic Limitations

- ◆ **Slater Road will be closed at this location during construction.**
- ◆ Construction is expected to start in the spring of 2017 and run through late 2017/early 2018.
- ◆ A signed detour route will be in place during construction which will likely include Elder Road, Unick Road and Lake Terrell Road for local traffic.
- ◆ A truck detour will likely include I-5, Grandview Road, Kickerville Road and Lake Terrell Road.

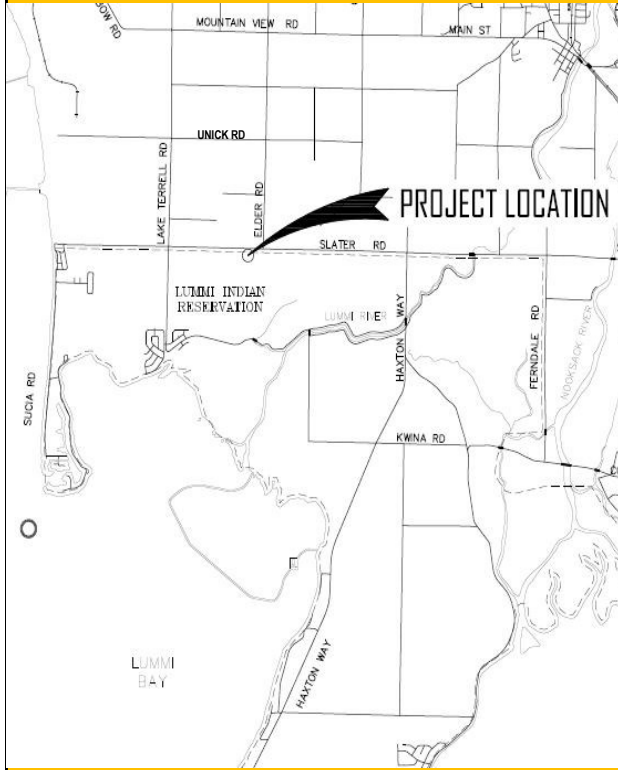
