

POPULATION CONTROL MEASURES:

When the Downtown Jail population reaches 205, the following Population Control Measures will apply to all Law Enforcement Agencies:

Probable Cause Arrests:

No Misdemeanor/Gross Misdemeanor charges EXCEPT FOR:

- ❖ Assault
- ❖ Domestic Violence Charges, including order violations
- ❖ DUI or similar impaired driving charges

Warrant Arrests (both In County and Out of County):

No warrants for DWLS 3rd

No warrants for Minor Misdemeanor warrants such as

- ❖ Trespass
- ❖ Shoplifting
- ❖ Disorderly conduct

When the Downtown Jail population reaches 212, the following Population Control Measures will apply to all Law Enforcement Agencies:

Probable Cause Arrests:

No Misdemeanor/Gross Misdemeanor charges EXCEPT FOR:

- ❖ Assault
- ❖ Domestic Violence Charges, including order violations
- ❖ DUI or similar impaired driving charges

Warrant Arrests both (In-County and Out of County):

No Misdemeanor/Gross Misdemeanor FTA/C warrants EXCEPT FOR:

- ❖ Assault
- ❖ Domestic Violence Charges, including order violations
- ❖ DUI or similar impaired driving charges

EXCEPTIONS: If the arresting Officer/Deputy determines the offender: represents an imminent threat to public safety, has multiple warrants reflecting a long and *current* history of FTA warrants, or when there are other, extraordinary, circumstances, the agency supervisor/Sgt. should contact the on-shift Corrections Sergeant. The Corrections Sergeant will take into consideration the factors Sheriff Elfo outlined in his memo and make a decision whether or not to take the offender. Sergeants are encouraged to contact the Corrections Lieutenant or Chief if they have any questions or are having any issues with the requesting agency.

NOTE: If a person is booked on a felony charge and also has outstanding misdemeanor/gross misdemeanor warrants, they will be booked on all of the charges, including the misdemeanors.
