Project Details

- ◆ The Whatcom County Public Works Department is preparing to replace the existing 7-foot wide by 10-foot tall steel arch culvert under Slater Road at Jordan Creek.
- ◆ The existing culvert is deteriorated and considered a barrier to fish passage and will be replaced with a 142-foot span bridge.
- ◆ Razz Construction, Inc. has been selected to complete construction of this project.

Traffic Limitations

- ◆ **SLATER RD WILL BE CLOSED AT THIS LOCATION BEGINNING MAY 1, 2017.**
- ◆ Construction activities and the associated road closure is expected to continue into late 2017/early 2018.
- ◆ A signed detour route will be in place during construction which will include Elder Road, Unick Road and Lake Terrell Road for local traffic.
- ◆ The truck detour will include I-5, Grandview Road, Kickerville Road and Lake Terrell Road.

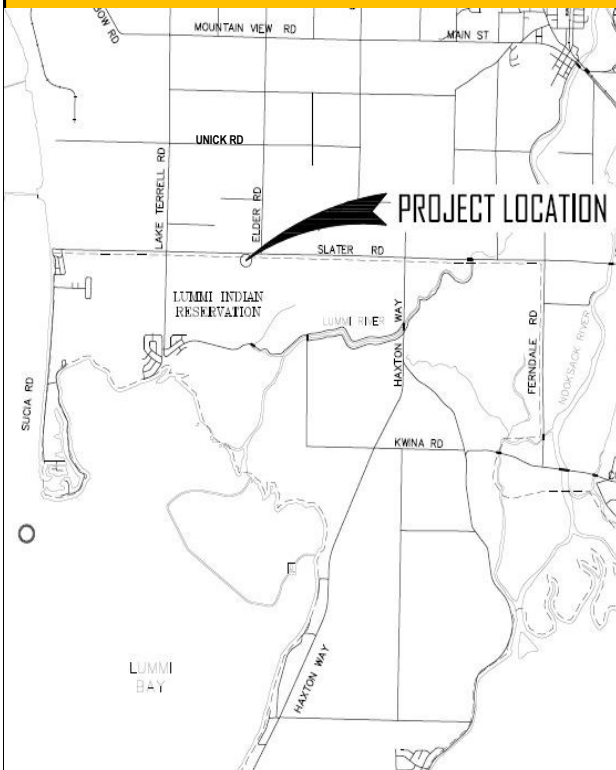
