This letter is a formal request for the Washington State Department of Ecology to become a co-lead agency with Whatcom County for the SEPA Environment Impact Statement (EIS) associated with the Gateway Pacific Terminal project. As outlined in WAC 197-11-944; two or more agencies may by agreement share or divide the responsibilities of lead agency through any arrangement agreed upon. As you are aware, Whatcom County and the United State Army Corp of Engineers (USACE) have agreed to share lead agency status for this project and will be preparing a combined National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA)/SEPA document. If your agency agrees to this request, we would like to prepare a written agreement outlining the responsibilities of all agencies with co-lead status for the environmental review process.
