



Registering to attend the

WHATCOM COUNTY DUI VICTIM IMPACT PANEL

To register for the Whatcom County DUI Victim Impact Panel, you must pay:

- Victim Impact Panel fee for **Adults 18 and older** = \$50.00
- Victim Impact Panel fee for **Youth 17 and younger** = \$20.00
- All fees are NON-REFUNDABLE

1. **Register Online.** Search “victim impact panel registration” from WhatcomCounty.us to access the online registration/payment form. **You may register online until 11:59 PM the day before a panel.**
2. **By mail, send a money order made out to Whatcom County Health Department. Mail to the address below and include the information requested.**

3. **In person at the Health Department located at 509 Girard Street. Office hours are 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM, Monday– Friday, and in-person registration deadline is 4:00 PM the day of a Panel. Payment may be made by cash, debit or credit. There is a convenience fee for payment by debit or credit.**

Once your payment has been received you will be assigned to the next available panel and given a referral form, which also serves as your receipt. Walk-ins will not receive certificates to prove their attendance. **Deadline to reschedule or request for a refund is 3:00 pm the day of the panel.**
