A candidate may mail the Declaration of Candidacy form accompanied by the filing fee to the Whatcom County Auditor's Office, Election Division, 311 Grand Ave., Suite 103, Bellingham, WA 98225. Filings can be received by mail beginning Wednesday, July 31, 2019, but will not be processed until the official 3-day filing period. Filings must be received no later than 4:30 pm on August 16. Any filing received before July 31 or after the deadline will be rejected and returned to the candidate.

Declarations of Candidacy *must be received* in the Auditor's Office no later than 4:30 p.m., Friday, August 16, 2019. Declarations of Candidacy received after the deadline will be invalid and returned to the applicant.
