Whatcom County is proposing new phosphorus neutral stormwater regulations for the Lake Whatcom Watershed (Proposed WCC 20.51<sup>1</sup>). County Council has asked staff to provide design and cost estimates for these stormwater systems on parcels smaller than 10,000 square feet. Engineering staff from the County, City, and Conservation District have framed up an approach, and the Engineering Services Division is currently working on detailed designs and review sheets. We are requesting rough cost estimates from the engineering community to design and install these systems. These cost estimates will be averaged and a range will be reported to Council without naming costs from specific firms.
