Hello County Council -

My name is Liisa Wale and I am writing to you to encourage you to keep strong to protect our climate and the waters/lands that are in this county. You are currently getting a lot of pressure from both sides, but must continue to stand strong against fossil fuel interests which do not protect the community or their workers long term.

Please support AB2019-597, an ordinance imposing an interim moratorium on the acceptance and processing of applications and permits for new or expanded facilities at Cherry Point. We can not have any further expansion out at Cherry Point without very strong regulations that support that protect the land, the people and future jobs.

I feel for the workers out at Cherry Point because they feel like their future is being threatened. Due to the way changing energy sources and climate is going those jobs (or at least many of them) will not be there in 20 years. We must work on solutions now to address that. When I speak out for no further expansion at Cherry Point I am also speaking out for the future of those workers and their health. If you do not standing up against expansion and unrefined fossils fuels you are putting those workers at risk.

Until the Cherry Point amendments process is complete it is very important to that process that the interim moratorium is extended.

Your decisions is not just about what will impact us now, but also 20 years from now.
