Elections

- Washington is a vote-by-mail state. You do not need to vote in person, as long as you are registered to vote.
- Voter registration and downloaded ballots are available through the state's VoteWa portal at <https://voter.votewa.gov/>
- You can register to vote online up to 8 days before election day. April 20, 2020 is the remote deadline to register to vote for the April 28 Special Election

Licensing

- Tab renewals can be completed online at www.dol.wa.gov. We will mail your registration and tabs the next business day.
