

We Scoop Prize Drawing & Photo Contest

Terms & Conditions of Participation:

A. Eligibility

1. The We Scoop Prize Drawing and Photo Contest are open to any dog-owning resident of Whatcom County.
2. To be eligible to enter the We Scoop Prize Drawing or Photo Contest, participants must complete either the Bellingham Scoop the Poop Pledge or the Whatcom County Scoop the Poop Pledge.
3. Entries will be accepted between August 1 and September 30.

B. We Scoop Prize Drawing

1. Pledge participants can enter the prize drawing via the City or County pledge page.
2. For each prize there will be four winners selected at random: three who live within Bellingham city limits, and one who lives within Whatcom County outside of Bellingham city limits.
3. Participants can enter the We Scoop Prize Drawing once per year. Participants can win one prize. Participants who have won a prize will not be eligible to win in future years.
4. Different people in the same household may each enter the drawing separately. Only one prize will be awarded per household. Households that have won a prize will not be eligible to win in future years.
5. Winners will be chosen by random drawing in three different rounds (August 23, September 21, and October 1, 2020).

C. We Scoop Photo Contest

1. Photo entries can be submitted by emailing the dog's photo and name, and the owner's name to PICProgram@co.whatcom.wa.us.
2. Judge's Choice Award winners will be selected by program staff. Photos must be high quality for printing, with good lighting and composition. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners will be announced by October 8, 2020.
3. People's Choice Award winners will be selected by a Facebook poll. Photos entered in the online poll will be pre-approved by program staff as long as they are in focus and deemed appropriate for public view. Voting will take place around October 15-28, 2020. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners will be announced by October 30, 2020.
4. Winning photos may be used in future outreach materials, including but not limited to bus ads, newspaper ads, posters, flyers, and Facebook page, as well as in other regional scoop the poop outreach.
