

## 2020 Passenger Only Vessel and Shuttle Van Operating Policy

This policy applies to individuals and household groups traveling on the **Island Commuter** passenger ferry and shuttle van during **this year's annual dry-dock service**. The policy balances predictable level of service, COVID guidelines, and operational safety measures **to ensure the health and safety of crew and passengers**.

### Passenger Only Vessel

- Hand sanitizing stations will be available.
- All passengers are required to wear face coverings on the vessel. If you do not have mask, one will be provided.
- Clear vinyl barriers between booth seating areas.
- Maximum number of passengers shall be 33 individuals, including those traveling in household groups.
- Additional runs offered during peak commute times at the Captain's discretion and depending on weather conditions.
- Signs, social media, and other outreach tools used to promote a responsible "stay-at-home, essential travel only" message, including postings on the vessel.
- Additional deck hand for continual cleaning between runs.

### Shuttle Van

- All passengers are required to wear face coverings in the van. If you do not have mask, one will be provided.
- Maximum number of passengers shall be 12 individuals, including those traveling in household groups.
- Installation of clear vinyl barriers between the rows of seating.
- Regularly cleaning of the van.

### **We ask Lummi Islander's to keep our crew and our community healthy and safe by:**

- Stay home, use the ferry and shuttle van for essential purposes only.
- Time your essential travel for least busy times.
- Wear face coverings at terminal areas, on the vessel, and on the shuttle van. If you do not have mask, one will be provided.
- Social distance, whenever possible.
- Be aware, be patient, be polite.
