The meeting tonight concerning amendments to the the Comprehensive Plan for Cherry Point should be tabled until the County has a clearer picture of what the loss of 700 jobs at Intalco and the havoc the Covid 19 virus is having on our economic stability. It is foolhardy to proceed with changes that could further disrupt our economy until we have a better understanding on our economic prospects for the future.

Further, the rationale that prompted the County Council on this change in zoning and additional requirements for even upgrades to the plant safety and environmental standards was ill conceived from the beginning and creates an environment of uncertainty about any future improvements to the plants. It also provides management a reason to invest money to improve operations in other locations where the rules are clearly defined and not subject to a great deal of second guessing.
