Requirements Before Issuance of Duplicate Instruments

Before a duplicate instrument is issued the issuing officer shall require the person making application for its issue to file in his office a written affidavit specifically alleging on oath that he is the proper owner, payee, or legal representative of such owner or payee of the original instrument, giving the date of issue, the number, amount, and for what services or claim or purpose the original instrument or series of instruments of which it is a part was issued, and that the same has been lost or destroyed, and not been paid or has not been received.

(Note: The State Legislature by enactment of Chapter 71, Laws of 1979, 1st Extraordinary Session, repealed that part of RCW 43.08.066 (2) that required the person making application for a duplicate instrument to give a bond in twice the fact amount of the original instrument. 09/01/79)
