The last several months have brought some exciting new developments for the South Fork Nooksack River Fish Camp (Ts'eq) Reach Integrated Design Project:

Based on the feedback at our first Community Workshop held on 6/27/19 at the Acme Presbyterian Church, the Project Design Team has identified five “concept zones” and developed design ideas for each zone. The team presented these design concept zones and ideas to the Acme-Van Zandt Flood Subzone Committee meeting on 9/18/19 and is currently conducting hydraulic analysis on these concepts before they are further developed or incorporated into Project Alternative Designs.
