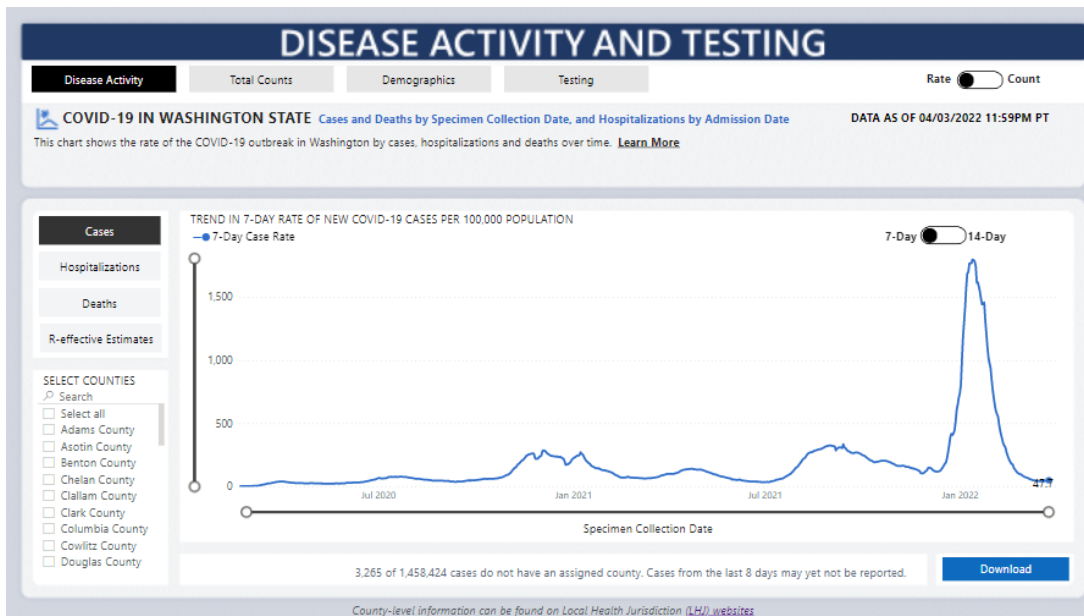
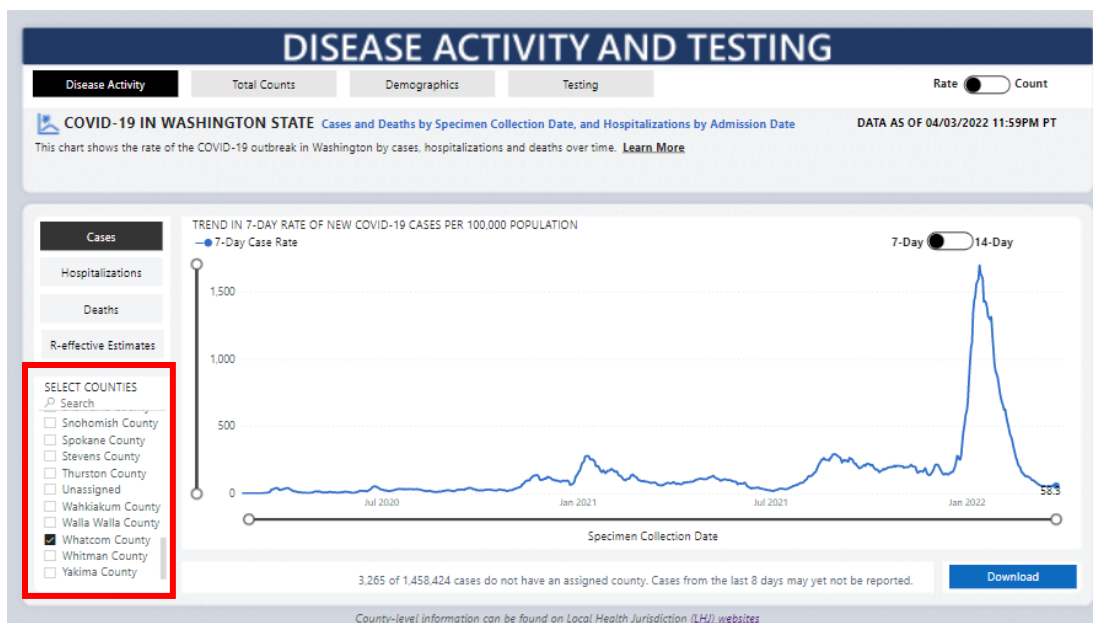


How to get to county-level data guide

- The COVID-19 data dashboard on Disease Activity and Testing displays data on all counties in the state of Washington as default.

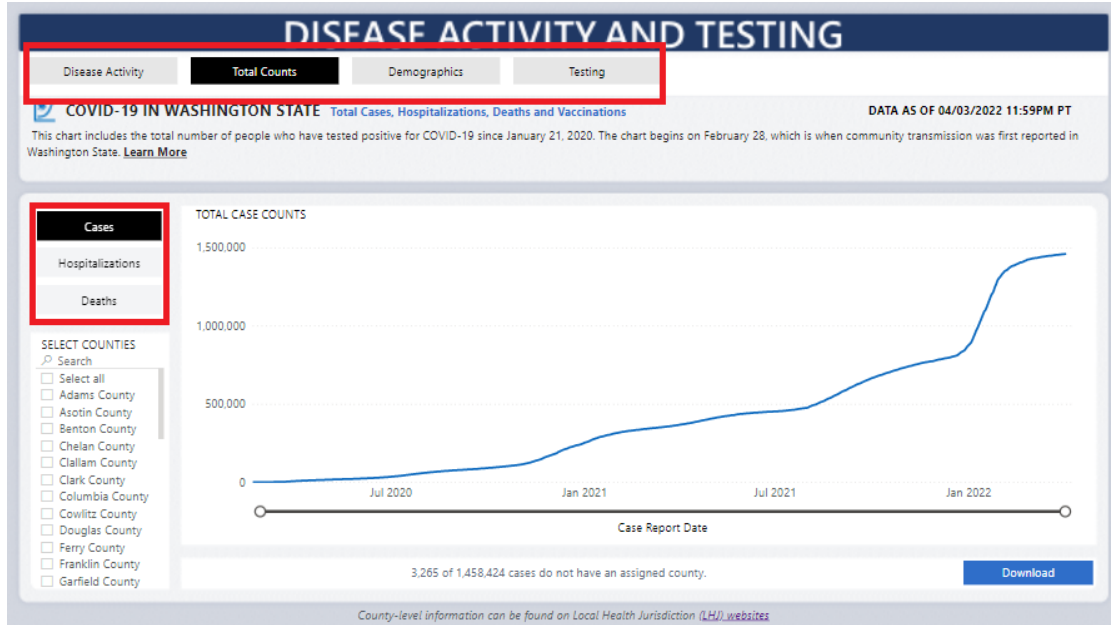


- To display data from a specific county, you must select the desired county (or counties) from the “SELECT COUNTIES” box in the lower left corner of the dashboard.

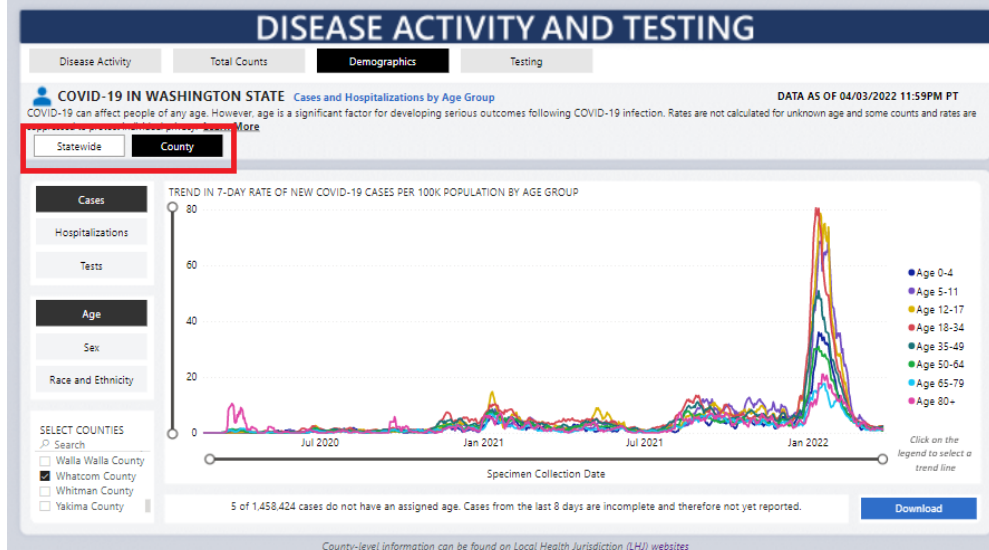
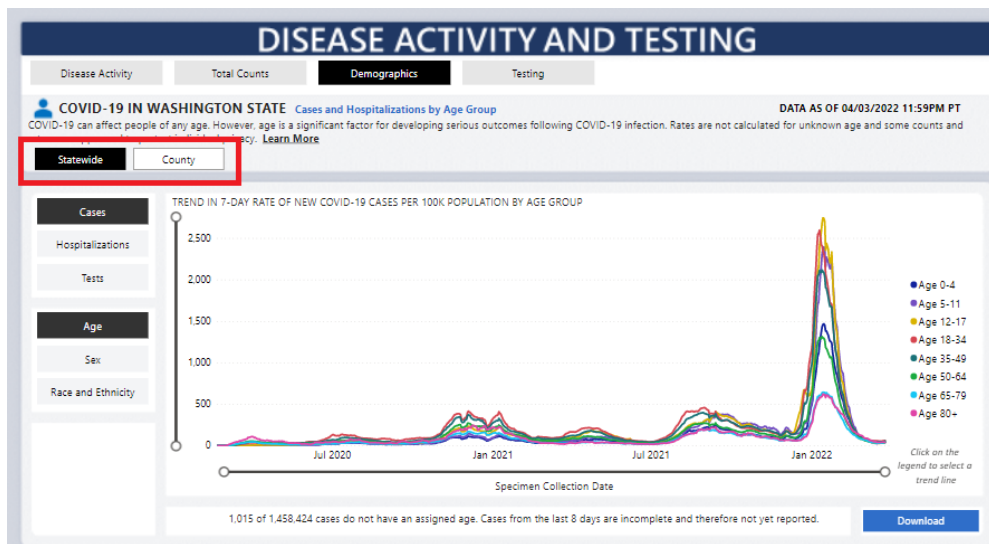


- To unselect a county, click on the box again so that it is unchecked.

- To view more data, explore the tabs on the top of the dashboard, and the upper left corner of the dashboard.



- When exploring the “Demographics” tab, you will need to select the “County” option at the top next to the “Statewide” option in order to filter the results by county.



- Once you have selected either “Statewide” or “County”, you may further filter the results using the options on the lefthand side of the dashboard. You can explore/select “Cases”, “Hospitalizations”, and “Tests” and view the data through the demographic filters, “Age”, “Sex”, and “Race and Ethnicity”.
