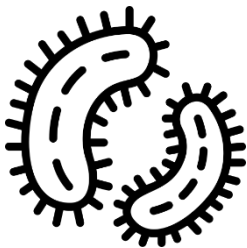
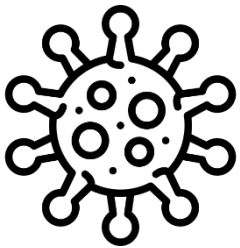


# Not Feeling Well?

## REPORT TO THE PERSON IN CHARGE IF YOU HAVE:



- **Diarrhea and/or vomiting.**
  - ❖ *Return to work 24 hours after symptoms stop.*
- **Fever with sore throat.**
  - ❖ *Return to work after all symptoms stop.*
- **Jaundice (yellow skin /eyes).**
  - ❖ *Return to work when approved by the Whatcom County Health Department.*
- **Infected, uncovered wounds.**
  - ❖ *Protect with an impermeable cover and, if on the hand or wrist, with a single-use glove.*
- **A diagnosed illness from an infection with:**
  - ❖ **Norovirus, Hepatitis A, Shigella, Salmonella, Shiga toxin-producing E. Coli.**
  - ❖ *Return to work when approved by the Whatcom County Health Department.*
