Educational Operation and Maintenance Levies

The Board of Directors of the Concrete School District No. 11 adopted Resolution No. 972 concerning a proposition for partial financing of the District's educational programs. This proposition would authorize the levy of the following excess taxes for the District's General Fund upon all taxable property in the District, to address the educational needs of students, to replace the expiring levy, and to pay a portion of the District's operation and maintenance expenses:

Replacement Educational Maintenance and Operations Levy

The Board of Directors of Ferndale School District adopted Resolution #37-2009 concerning educational funding. This proposition authorizes the District to levy the following excess taxes, to replace an expiring levy, on all taxable property within the District in addition to state funding, to maintain the District's educational programs and operations:

Proposition No. 1
Meridian School District No. 505
General Obligation Bonds - \$17,000,000

The Board of Directors of Meridian School District No. 505 approved a proposition for bonds.
