

Sample Ballot

Not all races on this sample will appear on your ballot. Only the races you are entitled to vote on will appear.

Whatcom County, Washington Primary Election - August 5, 2014

TO VOTE: Use blue or black ink to connect the arrow by your choice with a single line. Do **NOT** use felt tip pen or pencil.

Example: 

HOW TO CHANGE A VOTE: Draw a line through the incorrect choice. You have the option of making another choice.

WRITE-IN: To vote for a person not on the ballot, connect the arrow and write in the name of the person on the line provided.

If you vote more than once for an office or measure, no votes for that office or measure will be counted.

“READ: Each candidate for partisan office may state a political party that he or she prefers. A candidate’s preference does not imply that the candidate is nominated or endorsed by the party, or that the party approves of or associates with that candidate.”

Write-In	←	"For this office only: In order to vote for precinct committee officer, a partisan office, you must affirm that you are a Democrat or a Republican and may vote only for one candidate from the party you select. Your vote for a candidate affirms your affiliation with the same party as the candidate. This preference is private and will not be matched to your name or shared."
