IMPORTANT NOTICE
This sample ballot contains all of the major political party candidates, all nonpartisan candidates and issues certified to appear at our Primary Election on September 14, 2004. The nonpartisan candidates are those candidates not affiliated with a political party.

You will be given four ballots.
You must **CHOOSE, VOTE** and **RETURN** only **ONE** BALLOT.
You are entitled to vote on all of the nonpartisan races and issues on this ballot guide or votomatic, regardless of the party affiliation you may choose.

All voters are **NOT ENTITLED TO VOTE** on **ALL POLITICAL PARTIES**.
You may choose a political party ballot and vote for only that political party's candidates and the nonpartisan candidates; or, you may vote for the nonpartisan candidates only by choosing the nonpartisan ballot.

The color of the Political Party shown on your ballot card must match the color on the top of each page of the Political Party candidates in your guide. You may also vote for the nonpartisan candidates that are not color coded. If you vote for a candidate other than the political party ballot you have chosen your vote **WILL NOT COUNT**. In all cases your votes for the nonpartisan races or issues will count.

TO VOTE, FOLLOW THE EASY STEPS OUTLINED HERE.

- Using both hands, insert your ballot card in the slot. Insert your ballot card as far as it will go, positioning the two holes over the red pins on the voting device. Turn to the first ballot page.
- Using the voting stylus, record your vote by punching the hole indicated by the arrow for the candidate or measure of your choice. Continue turning the ballot pages and vote your selection of candidates or measures. Be certain that you vote all ballot pages.
- Lift your ballot from the red pins and remove it from the voting device.
