



NOTES:

1. A Trail Permit must be obtained before any work is done in County rights-of-way.
2. All disturbed ground shall be seeded and have satisfactory stand of grass prior to finalization of permit.
3. Remove existing soils under road and shoulder to root line to unyielding or undisturbed subgrade. Remove any organic soils.
4. Maintenance of the road within the public rights-of-way is the responsibility of the individual(s) holding a trail permit.
5. Contact County Division of Engineering for additional criteria and requirements for opening public rights-of-way.
6. Trail permit road improvement widths shall be as follows:
 - First permittee shall construct a 14 foot roadway of 6 inches compacted aggregate for gravel base.
 - Second permittee shall construct the road to 20 feet wide of 6 inches aggregate for gravel base.
 - Third permittee shall place 2 inches crushed top surfacing over the center 14 feet.
 All following permittees shall contact the County Engineer for specific improvements, which generally conform to 505.E-1 and 505.E-2.
